## Local Government

UCA 36-12-13(2)(c)

Enactment of this bill could cost local government operated disposal facilities, land treatment facilities, composting facilities, and transfer facilities \$286,100 one-time, in FY 2019, and \$572,200 ongoing, beginning in FY 2020, due to the new fee.

## Individuals & Businesses

UCA 36-12-13(2)(d)

Enactment of this bill could save commercial disposal facilities \$422,100 one-time, in FY 2019, and \$944,200 ongoing, beginning in FY 2020. Business landfills, coal ash facilities, land treatment facilities, composting facilities, and transfer facilities could see increased costs in the amount of \$333,000 one-time, in FY 2019, and \$666,000 ongoing, beginning in FY 2020, due to the new fee.
