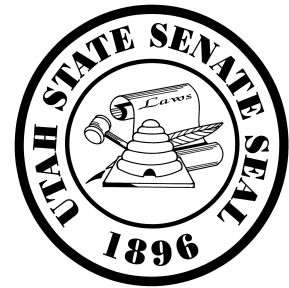

Enactment of this legislation likely will not materially impact state revenue.

Implementation of this bill will increase the education requirement for administrative law judges and may increase the Department of Workforce Services personnel costs by \$150,500 per year, \$16,100 of which would come from the General Fund. These costs will be phased in over the next few years due to employment turnover.
