New Services or Benefit

Public Benefit:

Purpose: The purpose of the new services is to provide a supplemental tool for English Language Arts Instruction for students in grades 4-12.

Services: Software licenses of selected providers found during an RFP process.

Expected Outcome: Expected outcome is that more students will demonstrate growth and/or proficiency in English Language Arts. The public will benefit by having a higher percentage of students prepared for college and careers.

Implementations and Resources: An RFP will be run to identify technology providers. As a result, LEAs will be able to apply, competitively, for software licenses to serve students in grades 4-12.

How: By providing software that targets individual students' learning needs improvements in educational outcomes will be attained.

Goal

Title: Students using the software provided will demonstrate statistically significant differences in compared to their peers not using the software in improved ELA outcomes.

Description: This is a pilot program good for one year. As such, the USBE will analyze students' SAGE data of those using the software and compare them to students not using the software to look at proficiency and growth measures.

Collection Method: Data and statistics will need to run an analysis of the students using the software in comparison to like peers not using the software and look at changes in SAGE outcomes.
