UCA 36-12-13(2)(b)

Enactment of this bill could increase Commerce Service Account revenue by \$6,400 annually. This revenue increase, combined with the Commerce Service Account costs identified below could reduce the year-end transfer to the General Fund by \$4,200 annually and by \$1,800 one-time in FY 2018.

Notes on Notes
