Enactment of this bill could result in \$45,000 ongoing dedicated credits in fee revenue for the Lieutenant Governor''s Office beginning in FY 2019 from fines for not completing harassment training by set deadlines and \$800 ongoing dedicated credits revenue beginning in FY 2019 for the Department of Human Resource Management from contracting with the executive or legislative branches to assist in harassment investigations. Enactment of this bill could also result in an unknown revenue amount beginning in FY 2019 to the Lieutenant Governor''s Office for each additional lobbyist found to have conducted unlawful harassment and fined \$2,000.

Enactment of this bill could cost the Lieutenant Governor''s Office \$300 one-time from the General Fund in FY 2019 for developing unlawful harassment training for lobbyists. It could also cost either the executive or legislative branch \$800 ongoing from the General Fund beginning in FY 2019 to contract with the Department of Human Resource Management to assist in harassment investigations. The executive and legislative branches and the Department of Human Resource Management can absorb the costs in their existing budgets.

Enactment of this legislation likely will not result in direct, measurable costs for local governments.

Individuals & Businesses

UCA 36-12-13(2)(e)

Enactment of this bill could cost and estimated five lobbyists untrained at the end of the calendar year \$1,000 each and an estimated twenty lobbyists who remain untrained over 180 days after the end of the calendar year \$2,000 each for a total of \$45,000 ongoing beginning in FY 2019 from fines for not completing harassment training by set deadlines. Enactment of this bill could also result in an unknown cost beginning in FY 2019 for each additional lobbyist found to have conducted unlawful harassment and fined \$2,000.

Regulatory Impact

Enactment of this legislation could result in a medium increase in the regulatory burden for Utah residents or businesses.

Notes on Notes
