Performance Note Report

Funding For: Serving a New or Larger Population

Public Benefit:

Purpose: Requires the Utah State Board of Education to manage Medicaid programs for all LEAs in the State of UTah.

Services: Presently Jordan School District contracts with a Medicaid provider to calculate and submit the Medicaid administrative cost calculation for all participating LEAs. Each school district submits their own fee for service Medicaid claims to Medicaid. This bill requires the USBE to take over these functions.

Expected Outcome: Increased participation by LEAs in the Medicaid programs and increased revenues for these services in public schools.

Implementations and Resources: The USBE will contract with one or more providers to calculate the Medicaid administrative cost calculation and to process fee for service claims. We will also require the contractor have a standardized systems and provide claims submission training and audit support.

How: We are requesting one time funds to enter into contracts with providers. The ongoing cost of the contracts will be funded by the Medicaid revenues.

Goal

Title: Increased participation by LEAs in the two Medicaid programs.

Description: Increased participation will be measured by number of LEAs or increases in Medicaid revenues.

Collection Method: Data from contractor, LEAs, and Medicaid.
