Enactment of this legislation appropriates \$1,000,000 ongoing from the General Fund and \$4,000,000 one-time to the Governor's Office of Economic Development - Talent Ready Utah - Utah Works Program. The bill also transfers funding and oversight of STEM Action Center program to the Department of Heritage and Arts and the STEM Endorsement program to the State Board of Education. These transfers are expected to be expenditure neutral.
