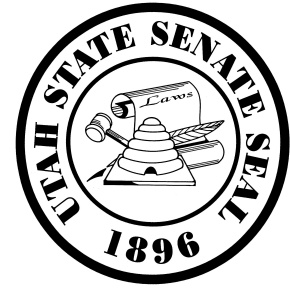

Enactment of this legislation could increase ongoing revenue to the following accounts beginning in FY 2021: (1) General Fund - \$5,400; (2) Criminal Surcharge - \$4,800; and (3) GFR - Court Security Account - \$300.

Enactment of this bill could cost the Courts about \$2,000 ongoing from the General Fund beginning in FY 2021 to process approximately five cases. Courts has indicated that it can absorb the cost.

**Local Government**

UCA 36-12-13(2)(c)

Enactment of this legislation likely will not result in direct, measurable costs for local governments.

**Individuals & Businesses**

UCA 36-12-13(2)(c)

Approximately five individuals could pay about \$2,100 more in fines per conviction for assaulting or threatening violence against medical service workers, for a total of approximately \$10,500 ongoing beginning in FY 2021.

**Regulatory Impact**

UCA 36-12-13(2)(d)

Enactment of this legislation likely will not change the regulatory burden for Utah residents or businesses.

**Notes on Notes**
