Enactment of this legislation may cost the Department of Health from the Children's Hearing Aid Program Restricted Account \$1,500 one-time in FY 2021 and \$800 ongoing beginning in FY 2022 for staff time to set up, solicit, and process donations as well as a reduction in staff time for no longer having to create an annual report.
