Performance Note Report

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Agency: Department of Human Services

Serving a New or Larger Population

Public Benefit:

Purpose: The new language adds technical assistance in the training for the prevention of suicide. On July 1st, the division shall solicit applications from healthcare organizations (HO) to receive technical assistance. The division shall approve at least one but no more than six. Applications shall contain: identify population, how HO will implement training, identify current resources, and how the population will benefit.

Services: Technical training for suicide prevention for at least one, but no more than 6 HOs.

Expected Outcome: Increased knowledge in the HO on how to appropriately recognize suicidal ideations and prevent suicide. The public will benefit from reduced suicides and the trauma and financial hardship that follow.

Implementations and Resources: The division shall advertise the availability of the technical service and solicit applications. The division will further select candidates as outlined and perform the training.

How: The training will further spread best practices and evidence-based approaches to help those at risk of suicide. In essence, our workforce becomes more productive at recognizing and preventing suicide.

Performance Measures

Goal

Title: Reduction of Suicide through technical assistance training of HO.

Description: Spread best practices and evidence-based approaches to HO to assist in reducing the incidence of suicide with technical assistance and training of HO. The measure is the number of organizations participating in the technical assistance and making suicide-specific quality improvement plans.

Collection Method: Program managers will provide technical assistance, identify coaches, monitor quality improvement plans, and provide progress reports to collect and monitor data.

Goal

Title: Improved ability of health care providers to identify and respond to individuals with risk of suicide.

Description: Spread best practices and evidence-based approaches to HO to assist in reducing the incidence of suicide with technical assistance and training of HO. The measure is the number of trainings provided and the number of individuals trained.

Collection Method: Program staff will contract for services with data reporting requirements, provide ongoing contract monitoring, require regular reporting, and technical assistance to ensure performance and reliability.
