New Services or Benefit

Public Benefit:

Purpose: This bill would make certain restrictions to Medicaid eligibility.

Services: The bill would reduce hospital presumptive eligibility, eliminate ex parte renewals and require all redeterminations after the public health emergency to occur within 120 days.

Expected Outcome: Eligibility redeterminations after the public health emergency will occur more timely.

Implementations and Resources: The Department of Workforce Services will need more staffing resources after the public health emergency.

How: The increased staffing resources will allow the State to complete the redeterminations within 120 days.

Performance Measures

Goal

Title: Timely completion of redeterminations.

Description: After the public health emergency ends, the State will redetermine eligibility for cases that have not been redetermined within the last 12 months and will complete 100% of these cases within 120 days.

Collection Method: DWS will need to provide the data to verify this performance.
