Program Manager – State and Local Engagement

Description: The Southwest Energy Efficiency Project (SWEEP) is seeking a Program Manager in its Boulder, CO office. The main responsibilities for this position include:

- Outreach and assistance to state energy offices and local governments in order to expand and improve energy efficiency efforts at the state and local levels in the Southwest;
- Outreach to state agencies and other organizations concerning the role that energy efficiency can play in the implementation of forthcoming CO₂ emissions standards for existing power plants; and
- Assistance on other projects as needs arise.

The Program Manager will carry out these activities in collaboration with other SWEEP staff and our state representatives, as well as through interaction with other energy efficiency and clean energy advocacy organizations.

Qualifications: Applicants should have experience working on energy efficiency policy or programs for an advocacy group, research or consulting firm, or governmental entity. Masters degree plus at least three years of experience or Bachelors degree plus at least five years of experience. Strong analytical, writing and communications skills, ability to work both collaboratively and independently, and a personal commitment to a cleaner environment and more sustainable future. Experience working for non-profit organizations is a plus.
