78B-3-906 Post-trial motions -- Appeals.

- (1) A party may move for a new trial or appeal a judgment only on the following grounds:
 - (a) judicial misconduct that materially affected the substantive rights of a party;
 - (b) misconduct of the jury;
 - (c) corruption, fraud, or other undue means employed in the proceedings of the court, jury, or adverse party that prevented a party from having a fair trial; or
 - (d) to correct errors of law.
- (2) Parties may file post-trial motions:
 - (a) relating to costs and attorney fees;
 - (b) to correct a clerical error in a judgment; and
 - (c) to enforce a judgment.
