AN ACT RELATING TO HIGHER EDUCATION; APPROPRIATING ~~h~~ **[\$800,000]** **\$300,000** ~~h~~ FOR FISCAL YEAR 1998-99 TO THE STATE BOARD OF REGENTS FOR ADULT APPRENTICESHIP-RELATED INSTRUCTION PROGRAMS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

This act enacts uncodified material.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Appropriation.

(1) There is appropriated from the General Fund for fiscal year 1998-99, ~~h~~ **[\$800,000]** **\$300,000** ~~h~~ to the State Board of Regents for adult apprenticeship-related instruction programs at the state's nine institutions of higher education to:

(a) coordinate essential training programs designed to provide highly skilled workers throughout the state which are needed by the crafts and trades industry and consumers;

(b) coordinate the development and distribution of statewide articulated ~~§~~ **[curriculum within 23 subject areas] CURRICULA § ; and**

(c) coordinate the development and distribution of the articulated curriculum needed in rural locations throughout the state using distance learning delivery systems.

~~h [(2) It is the intent of the Legislature that this appropriation be ongoing.] h~~

~~h [(3)] (2) h~~ The funds shall be distributed based on a formula driven by annualized apprenticeship full-time enrollments.

Section 2. Effective date.

This act takes effect on July 1, 1998.
