2 (d) the distribution of the revenues in relation to where they are generated and where they  
3 are spent.

4 (3) The board shall complete its study by December 31, 1998, and make a report to the  
5 Legislature prior to its 1999 General Session, together with any proposed recommendations for  
6 legislation that may be required to implement such a program.

7 Section 2. **Effective date.**

8 If approved by two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, this act takes effect  
9 upon approval by the governor, or the day following the constitutional time limit of Utah  
10 Constitution Article VII, Section 8, without the governor's signature, or in the case of a veto, the  
11 date of veto override.
