MOTION: Rep. Hendrickson moved all motions to be tentative till final voting. The motions passed unanimously.

Department of Environmental Quality Budgets

- Steve Higley disrupted a listing of accounts and restricted funds that have been created by the Legislature and are Utilized and administered by the Department of Environmental Quality.
- Mark Bleazard recommended an increase in the Petroleum Storage Tank Fund of \$67,300 to the Department of Environmental Quality financial summary FY 1999 analyst column on page 1 to total \$786,200 and a Department total of \$75,113,200.

- This would also increase the Environmental Response and Remediation program on page 9 to \$15,018,900

MOTION: Rep. Dillree moved the proposed changes and approve a Department of Environmental Quality FY 1999 budget of \$75,113,200. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Allen absent for the vote.
