H. B. 102 INSURANCE EXAM REQUIREMENTS REP. HOLLADAY

Rep. Holladay introduced the bill.

MOTION: Rep. Knudson moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 2, Line 14: After "(3)(a)" insert "(i)"

- 2, Page 2, Line 15: After line 15 insert:
 "(ii) A licensee may satisfy any or all hour requirements for an
educational prerequisite imposed under Subsection (3)(a)(i)
through courses provided by an insurer with whom the licensee is
associated."

MOTION: Rep. Barth moved to amend the bill as follows:

Page 2, Line 27 After "agent" insert "or previously agreed to in writing by both renter and owner or designated agent"
