S. B. 14 ELECTRONIC PROCESS FOR PAYROLL SEN. HOLMGREN

Sen. John Holmgren introduced the bill.

MOTION: Rep. Knudson moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 2, Line 11: Reinstate line 11 and after "(3)(a)" delete "An" and insert "Except as provided in Subsection (3)(b), an" and after "employee may" delete "elect to not" and insert "refuse to"
2. Page 2, Line 12: Reinstate line 12 and after line 12 insert:

"(b) An employee may not refuse to have the employee's wages deposited by electronic transfer under Subsection (3)(a) if:
(i) for the calendar year proceeding the pay-period for which the employee is being paid, the employer's federal employment tax deposits were equal to or in excess of \$250,000; and
(ii) at least two-thirds of the employees of the employer have their wages deposited by electronic transfer."

3. Page 2, Line 13: Delete "(3)" and insert "(c)"

The motion passed unanimously with Reps. Barth, Bradshaw, Bush, Pace and Way absent for the vote.

MOTION: Rep. Arent moved the bill be passed out favorably as amended. The motion passed unanimously with Reps. Bush, Pace and Way absent for the vote.

5. Page 11, Line 9: Delete "15" and insert "nine"
6. Page 12, Line 6: Delete "and"
7. Page 12, Line 6: After line 6 insert:
"(12) failing as an apprentice supervisor to comply with division rules relating to apprenticeship programs under this chapter; and"
8. Page 12, Line 7: Bracket "(12)" and insert "(13)"

The motion passed unanimously with Reps. Bush and Pace absent for the vote.
