**H. B. 8 STATE TREASURER AMENDMENTS** - Rep. J. Murray

2. Page 4, Line 7:     After line 7 insert:  
                          "(6) "Warrant" means an order in a specific amount drawn upon the treasurer by the Division of Finance or another state agency."

The motion passed unanimously with Reps. Beck, Hendrickson, and Zolman.

7. Page 1, Line 23: After "office" delete the comma and insert a semicolon
