The meeting began at 3:20 p.m. with Vice-Chair Holladay conducting.

MOTION: Representative Dayton moved that the minutes of the January 30, 1998 meeting be approved. The motion passed unanimously with Representatives Davis and Short absent for the vote.

H.B. 27 DENTAL CARE - USE OF GENERAL ANESTHESIA
- Representative Robert H.M. Killpack

Representative Killpack introduced a substitute to the bill.

MOTION: Representative Killpack moved that First Substitute H.B. 27 replace H.B. 27. The motion passed unanimously with Representatives Carlson, Davis and Short absent for the vote.

Representative Killpack explained the substitute bill to the committee.

Dr. Charles Foster, Utah Dental Association, and Dr. Thomas C. Sorensen, Pedodontics, spoke in support of the bill.

John T. Nielsen, Utah Health Insurance Association, spoke in opposition to the bill. Larry Bunkall, Utah Manufacturers Association, spoke in opposition to the bill and indicated that the following groups have also expressed their opposition to the bill: Utah Food Industry Association, National Federation of Independent Business, Utah Farm Bureau, Associated General Contractors, Utah Petroleum Association, Utah Mining Association, Utah Taxpayers Association, Utah Broadcasters Association, Utah Mechanical Contractors Association, Western Petroleum Marketers Association, Utah Information Technologies Association, Utah Motor Transport Association, and Ogden/Weber Chamber of Commerce.

MOTION: Representative Killpack moved that the substitute bill be passed out favorably. The motion failed with Representatives Carlson, Davis, Walsh and Holladay voting no. Representative Dayton was absent for the vote.

CHILD WELFARE AMENDMENTS

- Representative J. Brent Haymond

Representative Haymond explained the bill to the committee. A substitute to this bill was adopted by the committee in the meeting of January 30, 1998.

MOTION: Representative Stephens moved that the substitute bill be amended as follows:

1. Page 9, Line 31: Delete "neglect" and insert "neglected"
2. Page 12, Line 26: After "health" delete "and" insert " ," and after "safety," insert "and welfare"
3. Page 13, Line 19: After "health" delete "and" insert " ," and after "safety" insert ",and welfare"
4. Page 15, Line 7: After "health" delete "and" insert " ," and after "safety" insert ", and welfare"
5. Page 19, Line 3: After "health" delete "and" and insert " ,"
6. Page 19, Line 4: After "safety" insert ", and welfare"
7. Page 20, Line 22: After "safety" delete "and" insert " ," and after "protection" insert ", and welfare"
8. Page 48, Line 15: After "health" insert " ,"
9. Page 48, Line 16: At the beginning of line 16 delete "and" and after "safety" insert " ,"

and welfare"

10. Page 53, Line 28: After "health" delete "and" insert "," and after "safety" insert ", and welfare"
11. Page 54, Line 3: After "health" delete "and" insert "," and after "safety" insert ", and welfare"
12. Page 55, Line 5: After "health" delete "and" and insert "," and after "safety" insert ", and welfare"

The motion passed unanimously with Representatives Davis, Dayton and Killpack absent for the vote.

MOTION: Representative Stephens moved that the bill be amended as follows:

1. Page 12, Lines 1-4: Remove the brackets and reinsert the language on lines 1 through 4, and on line 4, delete "The"
2. Page 22, Line 23: After "guardian" delete the remainder of line 23
3. Page 22, Line 24: Delete "in an adoptive home"
4. Page 42, Lines 19-20: Remove brackets and reinstate the bracketed language

The motion passed unanimously with Representatives Davis, Dayton, Killpack and Short absent for the vote.

MOTION: Representative Stephens moved that the bill be amended as follows:

- Page 16, Line 1: After "statements" bracket "alone" and insert "in addition to the facts of the case"

Following committee discussion, the motion was withdrawn by the sponsor.

Representative Haymond explained the amended bill to the committee with the assistance of Carol Verdoia, Attorney General's Office, and Robin Arnold-Williams, Department of Human Services.

Kristen Brewer, Office of the Guardian Ad Litem, and Janetha W. Hancock, Associate General Counsel, Office of Legislative Research and General Counsel, answered questions of committee members.

EMERGENCY CARE TRAINING

Representative Valentine introduced a substitute to the bill.

MOTION: Representative Davis moved that First Substitute H.B. 98 replace H.B. 98. The motion passed unanimously with Representative Holladay absent for the vote.

MOTION: Representative Davis moved that the substitute bill be amended as follows:

1. Page 1, Line 6: Delete "AN" and insert "A FULLY"
2. Page 1, Line 13: After "26-8-7.5." insert "**Fully**"
3. Page 1 Line 15: Delete "an" and insert "a fully"
4. Page 1, Line 20: Delete "an" and insert "a fully"

The motion passed unanimously with Representative Holladay absent for the vote.

Representative Valentine explained the amended bill to the committee.

Val Bateman, Utah Medical Association, and T.J. Kennedy, Department of Public Safety, spoke in support of the bill.

MOTION: Representative Davis moved that the First Substitute H.B. 98 be passed out favorably as amended. The motion passed unanimously with Representative Holladay absent for the vote.

MOTION: Representative Walsh moved that the meeting be adjourned. The motion passed unanimously with Representative Holladay absent for the vote.
