



MOTION: Representative Baca moved that the bill be amended as follows:

1. Page 1, Line 17: After "rules insert ":(a)"
2. Page 1, Line 19: After "diseases" insert:  
"; and  
(b) that ensure that no treatment for serious mental illness that has been empirically shown to be efficacious is excluded from coverage"

The motion failed with Representative Baca voting yes.

MOTION: Representative Baca moved that the bill be passed out favorably.

SUBSTITUTE MOTION: Representative Walsh moved that the substitute bill be held in committee with a recommendation that it be placed on interim study. The motion failed on a roll call vote. Representatives Dayton, Killpack, Walsh and Holladay voted yes. Representatives Baca, Carlson, Davis, Short and Stephens voted no. Representative Saunders was absent for the vote.

Voting then took place on the original motion of Representative Baca to pass the bill out favorably. The motion failed with Representatives Dayton, Killpack, Short, Walsh and Holladay voting no. Representative Saunders was absent for the vote.

## **H.B. 105**

### **PRESCRIPTION COVERAGE**

Representative Allen introduced a substitute to the bill.

MOTION: Representative Carlson moved that First Substitute H.B. 105 replace H.B. 105. The motion passed unanimously with Representatives Baca, Davis and Saunders absent for the vote.

Mary Ann Jordan spoke in opposition to the bill.

MOTION: Representative Carlson moved that the bill be passed out favorably. The motion passed with Representatives Dayton, Short and Stephens voting no.

MOTION: Representative Short moved that H.B. 38 be placed on the agenda of the next committee meeting. The motion failed with Representatives Dayton, Killpack, Saunders, Walsh and Holladay voting

no.
