Goldenrod 2-11-98: Delete all of lines 19b and 19c

9. Page 3, Line 14: After "committed a" delete "crime" and insert "felony or misdemeanor"

 11. Page 3, Line 18: After "officer's" delete "detention of the person" and insert "conduct"
 12. Page 3, Line 20: At the beginning of line 20 delete "crime" and insert "felony or misdemeanor"
 13. Page 3, Line 27: After "as defined in" delete "Subsection 17A-2-1004(7)" and insert "Section 17A-2-1004"
 14. Page 4, Line 11: After "as defined in" delete "Subsection" and insert "Section"
 15. Page 4, Line 12: At the beginning of line 12 delete "17A-2-1004(6)" and insert "17A-2-1004"
