H.B. 345 Notaries Public Revision (K. Bryson)

Representative Bryson explained that the bill provided definitions, requirements for official signature, and fee structure. It is a protection to new citizens to this country.

1. Page 2, Line 20: Delete "recordable" and insert "recorded"
2. Page 7, Line 10: Delete "\$10" and insert "\$5"

MOTION: Rep. Goodfellow moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 8, Line 10: Delete "f" and insert "If"

The motion passed unanimously.

Fran Fish, Department of Commerce, spoke to the committee and answered questions.

MOTION: Rep. Dayton moved to pass the bill out favorably.

Questions were raised by the committee on page 7, line 3, 6-7: and page 6, line 4.

Voting was taken on the motion.

The motion passed with Reps. Stephens, Adair, and Alexander voting in opposition.
