**MOTION:**   Sen. Mayne moved to approve the minutes of Wednesday, February 11, 1998.

The motion passed unanimously with Sens. Buhler and Nielson absent for the vote.

**1. S.B. 172, Apprenticeship Training Funding (*M. Waddoups*)**

Sen. Waddoups requested an amendment to SB 172.

**MOTION:**   Sen. Wharton moved to amend the bill as follows:

Page 1, Lines 17-18   Delete "curriculum within 23 subject areas" and insert "curricula"

**2. H.B. 89, Restrictions on Names of Business Entities (*K. Bryson*)**

2. Page 2, Line 3 Reinstate "when requested by the examining body"

**4. H.B. 180, Extension of Gas Service Territories (*T. Hatch*)**

2. Page 2, Line 16  
Lilac 1-28-98: After "will" delete "or may"
