Under the direction of Committee Chair Poulton, Sen. Nielson called the meeting to order at 4:23 p.m.

MOTION: Sen. Wharton moved to approve the minutes of Friday, February 13, 1998.

The motion passed unanimously with Sen. Poulton absent for the vote.

1. S.B. 198, Mold Retention Law, Mold Lien Law, and Creditor's Rights (*M. Dmitrich*)

Sen. Dmitrich presented the bill.
Speaking for: Jeff Clark, Utah Plastics Group Inc.

MOTION: Sen. Wharton moved to pass SB 198 out of committee with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed unanimously with Sen. Poulton absent for the vote.

2. S.B. 190, Credit Card Amendments (*D. Buhler*)

Sen. Buhler presented the bill.

MOTION: Sen. Wharton moved to pass SB 190 out of committee with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed unanimously with Sen. Poulton absent for the vote.

3. H.B. 290, Engineer License Amendments (*M. Dillree*)

MOTION: Sen. Mansell moved to pass HB 290 out of committee with a favorable recommendation.

4. H.B. 277, Limited Liability Company Amendments (*S. Allen*)

5. S.B. 207, Professional Boxing Act Amendments (*P. Suazo*)

MOTION: Sen. Wharton moved to table SB 207.

SUBSTITUTE MOTION: Sen. Buhler moved to pass SB 207 out of committee with a favorable recommendation.

The substitute motion passed unanimously with Sen. Poulton absent for the vote.

6. H.B. 323, Amendments Related to Limited Liability Companies (*J. Valentine*)

Rep. Valentine presented the bill.

MOTION: Sen. Wharton moved to pass HB 323 out of committee with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed unanimously with Sen. Poulton absent for the vote.

MOTION: Sen. Buhler moved to recommend that HB 323 be placed on the Consent Calendar.

The motion passed unanimously with Sen. Poulton absent for the vote.

7. S.B. 36, Division of Occupational and Professional Licensing Act Amendments (S. Howell)

Sen. Howell requested 1st Sub SB 36.

MOTION: Sen. Mansell moved to adopt 1st Sub SB 36 for consideration.

The motion passed unanimously with Sen. Poulton absent for the vote.

Sen. Howell presented the bill. Sen. Buhler declared a conflict of interest.

MOTION: Sen. Mansell moved to amend the bill as follows:

Page 7, Lines 5-6: Delete lines 5-6

Speaking against the motion: Ray Walker, DOPL

SUBSTITUTE MOTION: Sen. Wharton moved to divide the motion.

The substitute motion failed on a tie with Sens. Buhler, Mayne and Wharton voting for and Sens. Poulton, Mansell, and Nielson voting against.

The motion to amend 1st Sub SB 36 failed with Sens. Poulton and Mansell voting for and Sens. Buhler, Mayne, Nielson, and Wharton voting against.

MOTION: Sen. Buhler moved to amend the bill as follows:

Page 7, Line 6: Delete line 6

The motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Sen. Wharton moved to hold 1st Sub SB 36 for further consideration.

Sen. Howell spoke against the motion to hold the bill.

SUBSTITUTE MOTION: Sen. Mansell moved to amend the bill as follows:

Page 7, Line 5: Delete line 5

The motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Sen. Nielson moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 1, Line 13: Delete "PROVIDING ADMINISTRATIVE FINE AND"
2. Page 1, Line 14: Delete "CITATION AUTHORITY; PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT;"
3. Page 1, Line 25: Delete line 25

The motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Sen. Mayne moved to pass 1st Sub SB 36 as amended out of committee with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed with Sens. Buhler, Mansell, Mayne, Nielson, and Wharton voting for and Sen. Poulton voting against.

Sen. Poulton took the chair.

8. S.B. 60, Motor Vehicle Insurance - Liability on Rental or Loaned Vehicle (*G. Mantes*)

Sen. Mantes explained the bill.

Speaking for: Representative from Rental Car Association

MOTION: Sen. Wharton moved to hold SB 60 for further consideration.

The motion passed unanimously.

9. H.B. 259, Sale of Vehicle (*B. Allen*)

Rep. B. Allen presented the bill.

MOTION: Sen. Wharton moved to pass HB 259 out of committee with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Sen. Nielson moved to recommend that HB 259 be placed on the Consent Calendar.

The motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Sen. Mayne moved to adjourn.

The motion passed unanimously.
