Chair Muhlestein called the meeting to order at 4:40 p.m.

**MOTION:** Senator Holmgren moved to adopt the minutes of February 23, 1998.

The motion passed unanimously.

1. **1<sup>st</sup> Sub. H.B. 32 Disclosure of Tobacco Ingredients** (*J. Tanner*)

Representative Tanner explained the bill.

**MOTION:** Senator Montgomery moved to pass the bill out favorably.

The motion passed unanimously.

2. **H.B. 337 Regulation of Cork-finished Wine Tasting** (*J. Hickman*)

Representative Hickman explained the bill.

**MOTION:** Senator Peterson moved to pass the bill out favorably.

The motion passed unanimously.

3. **H.C.R. 11 Resolution Approving Industrial Waste Permit** (*B. Evans*)

Representative Evans explained the bill, and suggested the following amendments:

1. Page 2, Line 2: After "Quality," delete "but" and insert "and"

After "likely" delete "extend beyond the final day" and insert "result in approval by the Department of Environmental Quality before the end"

2. Page 2, Line 3: Delete "1997" and insert "1998"
3. Page 2, Line 6: Delete ", and shall be considered as subsequent"
4. Page 2, Line 7: Delete "to" at the beginning of the line
5. Page 2, Line 8: Delete ", and" at the end of the line
6. Page 2, Line 9: Delete entire line
7. Page 2, Line 10: Delete "jurisdiction over the site" but do not delete "."

**MOTION:** Senator Montgomery moved to adopt the amendments.

The motion passed unanimously.

**MOTION:** Senator Peterson moved to pass the bill out favorably as amended.

The motion passed unanimously.

**4. H.B. 153 Tire Recycling Amendments (D. Ure)**
