Chair Taylor called the meeting to order at 2:20 p.m. and welcomed all present and introduced staff.

**1. S.B. 15 Statute of Limitations on Prosecuting for Bribery (J. Hull)**

Sen. Hull presented the bill. Creighton Horton, Attorney General's office, assisted in presenting the bill and responded to questions from committee members.

**MOTION:** Sen. Hillyard moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 1, Line 16: After "within" delete "four" and insert "two"

**MOTION:** Sen. Buhler moved to pass S.B. 15 out of committee with a favorable recommendation. The motion passed unanimously.

**2. S.B. 81 Reauthorization of Juvenile Justice Task Force (L. Hillyard)**

Sen. Hillyard presented the bill. Ed McConkie spoke in favor of the bill.

Sen. Taylor commended Sen. Hillyard on his leadership on the task force studying this issue and encouraged continued reporting on progress.

Wayne Holland, Youth Private Providers, spoke in favor of the bill.

**MOTION:** Sen. Steiner moved to pass S.B. 81 out of committee with a favorable recommendation. The motion passed unanimously.

**3. S.B. 75 Uniform Probate Code Amendments (L. Hillyard)**

Sen. Hillyard presented the bill. Mark Lehman and Thomas Christensen, Estate Planning Section

of the Utah State Bar, assisted with the presentation of the bill and responded to questions from committee members. They distributed a handout "Uniform Probate Code and Perpetuities Amendments Statutory Overview" and discussed its contents.

John Nelson, Utah State Bar Commission, spoke in favor of the bill.

**MOTION:** Sen. Hillyard moved to pass S.B. 75 out of committee with a favorable recommendation. The motion passed unanimously.

Agenda item #4 "Utah Tomorrow Report on Justice Section" was moved to an agenda item for the next committee meeting.

The meeting was adjourned at 3:10 p.m.
