MOTION: Sen. Stephenson moved to approve the minutes of February 24, 1998.

1. **HB 65S1 SALES TAX EXEMPTION FOR PASSENGER TRANSPORTATION**(B. Allen)

Sen. Allen presented the bill to the committee.

MOTION: Sen. Dmitrich moved to pass the bill with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed unanimously.

2. **HB 110 SALES TAX EXEMPTION FOR SEASONAL DESTINATION AMUSEMENT PARKS** (*M. Dillree*)

Sen. Stephenson, representing Rep. Dillree, presented the bill to the committee.

MOTION: Sen. Dmitrich moved to pass the bill with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed unanimously.

3. **HB 171 MOBILE HOME AND MANUFACTURED HOME AMENDMENTS** (*C. Buttars*)

Rep. Buttars presented the bill to the committee, with the assistance of Dennis Ayres, Iron County Assessor.

MOTION: Sen. Dmitrich moved to pass the bill with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed unanimously.

4. **HB 199S1 APPROPRIATION TO SPECIES PROTECTION ACCOUNT** (*T. Hatch*)

Rep. Hatch presented the bill to the committee.

MOTION: Sen. Waddoups moved to adopt the amendments as follows:

1. Page 1, Line 5: After "APPROPRIATING" delete "\$900,000" and insert "\$150,000"
2. Page 1, Line 11: After "appropriated" delete "\$900,000" and insert "\$150,000"

The motion passed unanimously.

5. **HB 322 FISCAL NOTE ON LEGISLATION** (*M. Stephens*)

6. **HB 380 SALES TAX EXEMPTION FOR POLLUTION CONTROL** (*J. Valentine*)

The motion passed unanimously.

7. **HB 421S1 REIMBURSEMENT OF LEGAL FEES AND COSTS TO OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES** (*M Styler*)

Rep. Styler presented the bill to the committee.

MOTION: Rep. Waddoups moved to pass the bill with a favorable recommendation.

8. **HB 425S1 PROPERTY VALUATIONS FOR THE POOR** (*R. Short*)

Rep. Short presented the bill to the committee.

Dennis Ayres, Iron County Assessor, spoke in favor of the bill.

MOTION: Sen. Waddoups moved to pass the bill with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Sen. Dmitrich moved to add **SB 91** and **SB 217** to the agenda.

The motion failed with Sens. Dmitrich and Nielson voting in favor, and Sens. Montgomery, Stephenson and Montgomery voting against.

MOTION: Sen. Montgomery moved to adjourn.
