Senator Mansell called the meeting to order at 2:20 p.m.

1. **SB7 Special Fuel Tax Certificate Repeal, Senator Steele**

Senator Steele explained the bill with the assistance of Rod Morelli, Tax Commission.

MOTION: Senator Steele moved to send the bill to the secretary of the senate and to recommend the bill for interim study.

The motion passed unanimously.

2. **SB6 Enforcement and Penalties of Uninsured Motor Vehicle Violations, Senator Steele**

Senator Steele explained the bill to the committee with the assistance of Richard Kasteller of Insure Right and Skip Nelson, Driver License Division. Senator Steele moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 1, Line 10: After "PROGRAM;" insert "PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN AUDITS;"
2. Page 6, Line 25: After line 25 insert
 "(8)(a) The designated agent shall archive computer data files at least semi-annually for auditing purposes.

(b) The internal audit unit of the Tax Commission provided under Section 59-1-206 shall audit the program at least annually. The audit shall include verification of:
(i) billings made by the designated agent; and
(ii) the accuracy of the designated agent's matching of vehicle registration with insurance data."

3. Page 8, Line 30: Delete "or" and insert " , " and after "general" insert " , or other auditor of the state"

The motion passed unanimously.

Senator Steele moved to amend the bills as follows:

1. Page 2, Line 12: After "person" insert " : (i)"
2. Page 2, Line 14: After line 14 insert:
"or (ii) is under an administrative action taken by the Department of Public Safety for operating a registered motor vehicle without owner's or operator's security in effect as required under Section 41-12a-301;"
3. Page 4, Line 13: After line 13 insert:
"(c) Evidence of owner's or operator's security from the Uninsured Motorist Identification Database Program described under Subsection (2)(b)(vi) supercedes any evidence of owner's or operator's security described under Subsections (2)(b)(i)(C) or (D)."
4. Page 4, Line 25: Delete "may" and insert "shall"

The motion passed unanimously.

3. **SB8 Reauthorization of and Amendments to Uninsured Motorist Database Program**

Senator Steele explained the bill to committee. Don Taylor, Bennion Taylor Insurance spoke in favor of the bill.

Motion: Senator Waddoups moved to amend the bills as follows:

1. Page 2, Line 7: Delete "2002" and insert "2000"
2. Page 2, Line 17: Delete "2002" and insert "2000"

The motion passed with Senator Steele and Senator Mayne voting against the motion.

Motion: Senator Mayne moved to send the bill out with a favorable recommendation.
Motion passed unanimously.

4. Senate Bill 78 Master Road - State Highway List

Motion: Senator Mayne moved to adopt the first substitute to the bill.

The motion passed unanimously.

Senator Holmgren explained the bill to the committee with the assistance of Clint Topham, Dept. of Transportation.

Motion: Senator Mayne moved to send the bill out with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed unanimously

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Motion: Senator Waddoups moved to adjourn.

The motion passed unanimously.
