Chair Mansell called the meeting to order at 8:35 a.m

1. **MOTION:** Senator Tanner moved to approve the minutes of the Jan. 20, 1998, and Jan. 22, 1998, meetings.

The motion passed unanimously.

2. **SB 90 ASSAULTING A PEACE OFFICER** (*R. Evans*)

Sen. Evans presented the bill to the committee with the assistance of students from a political science class from Copper Hills High School.

Adrienne Bassett, Jared Kronenberg, Mandi Burton and Steve Burt, students, and Lee Perry, Utah Highway Patrol Assn., spoke in favor of the bill.

MOTION: Sen. Mayne moved to hold the bill until the next meeting.

SUBSTITUTE MOTION: Sen. Tanner moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 1, Line 18: Delete "180" and insert "90"
2. Page 1, Line 21: Delete "and" and insert ", or that the assault occurred during an act of civil disobedience, and the court"

Sen. Tanner moved to divide the motion.

The first amendment passed with Sen. Steele voting in opposition.

The second amendment passed with Sens. Mansell and Steele voting in opposition.

MOTION: Sen. Mayne moved to send the bill out with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed unanimously.

3. **SB 110 APPROPRIATION FOR OGDEN PARKWAY HIGHWAY UNDERPASS**
(*R. Montgomery*)

Sen. Montgomery presented the bill to the committee.

Greg Montgomery, Ogden City, and Wayne Parker, Ogden City, spoke in favor of the bill.

Sen. Tanner declared a conflict of interest.

Clint Topham, UDOT, answered questions from the committee.

MOTION: Sen. Tanner moved to send the bill out with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed with Sen. Mantes voting in opposition.

HB 202 TRANSPORTATION CODE RECODIFICATION (*M. Dillree*)

Rep. Dillree presented the bill to the committee.

MOTION: Sen. Waddoups moved to send the bill out with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed unanimously.

4. **SB 20 PENALTIES FOR SPEEDING IN CONSTRUCTION ZONES** (D Buhler)

Sen. Buhler presented the bill to the committee.

MOTION: Sen. Mayne moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 1, Line 22: Delete "the fine for the operator's speeding" and insert "a

fine imposed by the court that is at least double the fine in the uniform recommended fine schedule established under Section 76-3-301.5 for the offense."

2. Page 1, Line 23: Delete all of line 23

The motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Sen. Mantes moved to send the bill out with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed unanimously.

5. **SB 100 RADAR JAMMING DEVICES** (*J. Hull*)

Senator Hull presented the bill to the committee.

MOTION: Sen. Tanner moved to send the bill out with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Sen. Mantes moved to adjourn.

The motion passed unanimously.
