Committee Chair Mansell called the meeting to order at 8:35 a.m.

**MOTION:** Sen. Mantes moved to approve the minutes of February 12, 1998

The motion passed unanimously.

1.     **SB 143 RECREATIONAL VEHICLE STANDARDS** (*G. Mantes*)

**MOTION:** Sen. Mantes presented the bill to the committee and moved to amend the bill as follows:

1.   Page 3, Line 1:           Delete "truck camper,"

The motion passed unanimously.

Wayne Jones, Recreational Vehicle Dealers Assn., responded to questions from the committee.

**MOTION:** Sen. Mantes moved to send the bill out with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed unanimously.

2.     **HB 278 VEHICLE REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS** (*Rep. Saunders*)

Rep. Saunders distributed amendments and presented the bill to the committee.

**MOTION:** Rep. Tanner moved to adopt the amendments as follows:

1. Page 1, Line 25: After "Beginning" insert "on the later date of" and after "2000," insert "or the date the commission's new motor vehicle system becomes operational,"
2. Page 2, Line 9: Delete "Beginning January 1, 2000, the" and insert "The"

The motion passed unanimously with Sen. Mansell absent for the vote.

Jonathan Ward and Val Oveson, State Tax Commission, commented.

Sen. Waddoups moved to send the bill out with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed with Sens. Steele, Tanner and Waddoups voting in favor, Sen. Mantes voting in opposition and Sen. Mansell absent for the vote.

3. **HB 272 INMATE PRODUCTIVITY AND WORK SKILLS** (*G. Adair*)

Sen. Tanner, representing Rep. Adair, presented the bill to the committee.

Sen. Steele assumed the chair.

**MOTION:** Sen. Tanner moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 2, Line 3: After "do not" insert "unfairly"

The motion passed unanimously with Sen. Mansell absent for the vote.

Jesse Gallegos, Dept. of Corrections, spoke in favor of the bill.

**MOTION:** Sen. Tanner moved to send the bill out with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed unanimously with Sen. Mansell absent for the vote.

4. **HB 242 REVOCATION OF CONCEALED FIREARM PERMIT AMENDMENTS**  
(*S. Barth*)

Rep. Barth presented the bill to the committee.

Robert Fisher commented.

**MOTION:** Sen. Tanner moved to send the bill out with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed unanimously.

5. **SB 200 BOATING LAW CHANGES** (*N. Tanner*)

Sen. Tanner presented the bill to the committee.

TedWooley, State Boating, spoke in favor of the bill.

**MOTION:** Sen. Waddoups moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 4, Line 7: Reinstated "Subsection (3)(a) need not"
2. Page 4, Line 8: Delete "this section must"

The motion passed unanimously.

**MOTION:** Sen. Tanner moved to send the bill out with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed unanimously.

6. **HB 33 COMMUNITY RESPONSIVENESS REQUIREMENTS OF UTAH  
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION** (*R. Becker*)

HB 33 was not considered due to the excused absence of the sponsor.

**MOTION:** Sen. Waddoups moved to adjourn

The motion passed unanimously with Sen. Mansell absent for the vote.
