Committee Chair Mansell called the meeting to order at 8:35 a.m.

MOTION: Sen. Tanner moved to approve the minutes of February 16, 1998.

The motion passed unanimously with Sen. Mayne absent for the vote.

1. **HB 123 NOT A DROP AMENDMENTS** (*D. Bush*)

Rep. Bush presented the bill to the committee with the assistance of Mary Lou Bozich, Utah Substance Abuse and Anti-Violence Coordinating Council.

MOTION: Sen. Tanner moved to pass the bill out with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Sen. Tanner moved to place the bill on the Consent Calendar.

The motion passed unanimously.

2. **HB 344 DUI PROBATION OR PAROLE** (*K. Bryson*)

Rep. Bryson presented the bill to the committee.

Richard Greenwood, Dept. of Public Safety, spoke in favor of the bill.

MOTION: Sen. Waddoups moved to send the bill out with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed unanimously.

3. **HB 33 COMMUNITY RESPONSIVENESS REQUIREMENTS OF UTAH DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION** (*R. Becker*)

Rep. Becker presented the bill to the committee.

Tom Warne, UDOT, spoke against the bill.

MOTION: Sen. Mayne moved to send the bill out with a favorable recommendation.

The motion failed with Sen. Mayne voting in favor and Sens. Mansell, Steele, Tanner and Waddoups voting in opposition.

4. **HB 307 REGULATION OF IMPOUNDED VEHICLES** (*C. Saunders*)

Rep. Saunders presented the bill to the committee.

Richard Greenwood, Dept. of Safety, and Val Oveson, Utah Tax Commission, responded to questions from the committee.

MOTION: Sen. Steele moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 2, Line 21b
Lilac 2-6-98: After "if" insert ":(a)"

2. Page 2, Line 21c
Lilac 2-6-98: After "odometer" insert ";and (b) the odometer reading is accessible to the division or the peace officer"

The motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Sen. Tanner moved to send the bill out, as amended, with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed with Sens. Mansell, Steele, Tanner and Mayne voting in favor and Sen. Waddoups voting in opposition

MOTION: Sen. Steele moved to adjourn.

The motion passed unanimously.
