1.    Page 2, Line 10:       Delete "52" and insert "53.5"
2.    Page 2, Line 11:       Delete "52" and insert "53.5"
3.    Page 3, Line 2:       Delete "8" and insert "6.5"

The motion passed unanimously.

**MOTION:** Sen. Steele distributed amendments to the committee and moved to adopt them as follows:

1.    Page 2, Line 3           After "radio communications access line" insert "with billing address within the boundaries of the area served by the public agency"

2. Page 2, Line 5:                   After "(b)" delete "(i)"
3. Page 2, Lines 7-9:               Delete lines 7-9
4. Page 2, Line 10:                After "charge" insert "levied under this section"

The motion passed unanimously

**MOTION:** Sen. Steele moved to send the bill out with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed with Sen. Waddoups voting in opposition.

2. **HB 90S1 MAIL BOX DAMAGE AND MAIL THEFT** (*Rep. Goodfellow*)
