MOTION: Sen. Tanner moved to approve the minutes of February 20, 1998.

The motion passed unanimously with Sen. Mantes absent for the vote.

1. **HB 462 MOTOR VEHICLE CRIMINAL ACTS AMENDMENTS** (*S. Barth*)

Rep. Barth presented the bill to the committee.

MOTION: Sen. Tanner moved to send the bill out with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed unanimously with Sen. Mantes absent for the vote.

MOTION: Sen. Tanner moved to place the bill on the Consent Calendar.

The motion passed unanimously with Sen. Mantes absent for the vote.

2. **1st Sub. HB 339 HILL AIR FORCE BASE ADDITION** (*G. Adair*)

Rep. Adair presented the bill to the committee.

Rex Hadley, Hill Museum, spoke in favor of the bill.

MOTION: Sen. Waddoups moved to send the bill out with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed unanimously with Sen. Mantes absent for the vote.

3. **1st Sub. HB 101 POSTING ON MOTOR AND SPECIAL FUEL PUMPS** (*G. Way*)

Rep. Way presented the bill to the committee.

Lee Peacock, Utah Petroleum Assn., expressed concerns with the bill.

MOTION: Sen. Waddoups moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 1, Line 5
Lilac 2-17-98: Reinststate "REQUIRING" and delete "ALLOWING"
2. Page 1, Line 15
Lilac 2-17-98: Reinststate "shall" and delete "may"

The motion passed unanimously with Sen. Mantes absent for the vote.

MOTION: Sen. Waddoups moved to send the bill out, as amended, with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed unanimously with Sen. Mantes absent for the vote.

4. **HB 131 ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY FOR DRUG LAB AND PRECURSOR ACTS** (A. Tyler)

Rep. Tyler presented the bill to the committee.

Lloyd Selleneit, Mineral Herbal Industry, expressed concerns with the bill. Earl Morris, Dept. of Public Safety, spoke in favor of the bill.

MOTION: Sen. Steele moved to send the bill out with a favorable recommendation.

MOTION: Sen. Steele moved to reconsider HB14S1 at the next meeting.

The motion passed with Sen. Mantes voting in opposition.

MOTION: Sen. Steele moved to adjourn.
