13	67-19-12.7. Accumulated annual leave Conversion to deferred compensation plan
14	(1) The department shall implement a program whereby an employee may, upon
15	termination of employment or retirement, elect to convert any unused annual leave into any of the
16	employee's designated deferred compensation accounts that:
17	(a) are sponsored by the Utah State Retirement Board; and
18	(b) are qualified under Section 401(k) or Section 457 of the Internal Revenue Code.
19	(2) Any annual leave converted under Subsection (1) shall be converted into the
20	employee's deferred compensation account at the employee's pay rate at the time of termination
21	<u>or retirement</u>
22	(3) No employee may convert hours of accrued annual leave to the extent that any hours
23	so converted would exceed the maximum amount authorized by the Internal Revenue Code for
24	each calendar year
