| 13 | WHEREAS, the preservation of open space is a priority in Utah cities and communities; |
| 14 | WHEREAS, Marriott-Slaterville City is Utah's newest city which bears a unique and |
| 15 | significant history dating back more than 150 years; |
| 16 | WHEREAS, it is necessary to involve local government, private foundations, and the |
| 17 | public in promoting open space preservation; |
| 18 | WHEREAS, the Marriott Heritage Foundation is currently successfully working in the |
| 19 | community to foster historical and open space projects such as Bingham's Fort, an early pioneer |
| 20 | settlement; the original transcontinental railroad route through the area; and historic Native |
| 21 | American grounds; |
| 22 | WHEREAS, as a new city, Marriott-Slaterville is in an exceptional position to develop a |
| 23 | zoning ordinance model using open space concepts; |
| 24 | WHEREAS, Marriott-Slaterville City contains river bed, wet land, and natural habitat areas |
| 25 | suitable for open space preservation, especially along the Weber River corridor; and |
| 26 | WHEREAS, the model set by an open space pilot program city may benefit other cities, |
| 27 | communities, and the public: |
