17	Controlled Substances;		
18	(b) gambling is permitted to be played, conducted, or dealt upon as prohibited in Title 76,		
19	Chapter 10, Part 11, Gambling, which creates the conditions of a nuisance as defined in Subsection		
20	78-38-1(1);		
21	(c) criminal activity is committed in concert with two or more persons as provided in		
22	Section 76-3-203.1;		
23	(d) parties occur frequently which create the conditions of a nuisance as defined in		
24	Subsection 78-38-1(1); [and]		
25	(e) prostitution or promotion of prostitution is regularly carried on by one or more persons

- (2) It is a defense to nuisance under Subsection (1)(a) if the defendant can prove [he] that the defendant is lawfully entitled to possession of a controlled substance.
- (3) Sections 78-38-10 through 78-38-16 govern only an abatement by eviction of the nuisance as defined in Subsection (1).
