16	(2) (a) A member may purchase or a member and an employing unit may jointly purchase
17	a combined maximum total of five years of retirement service credit which is not otherwise
18	purchasable under this chapter.
19	(b) The number of years of retirement service credit purchased may [not] exceed the
20	number of years required by the member to retire with no actuarial reduction.
21	(c) The purchase of retirement service credit must allow the member to meet the retirement
22	eligibility requirements of this system with no actuarial reduction.
23	(d) The member must retire effective immediately after the purchase of retirement service

28	(4) (a) The employing unit may elect to purchase retirement service credit for a member
29	under Subsection (2) while the member is on an unpaid leave of absence.
