MOTION: Rep. Bush moved that the minutes January 27,1999 be approved. The motion passed unanimously with Reps. Harper and Ure absent for the vote.

Neil Christensen spoke to the subcommittee about the Department of Transportation's Year 2000 compliance preparation. He identified critical mission systems that need to be in compliance by 2000.

Max Ditlevsen spoke to the subcommittee about the Administrative Function Study at the Rampton Complex.

David Miles spoke to the subcommittee about the Pavement Preservation Program background and program strategy. Linda Hull spoke about the estimated funds needed to maintain the status quo and the discussed the Department's strategy to maintain it.
