17	inspection sticker or certificate, and on which the required safety equipment has not been
18	subsequently modified;
19	(2) off-highway vehicles, except snowmobiles, that are not in the state more than 14 days
20	in any year and are owned by a nonresident;
21	(3) snowmobiles that are owned by a nonresident <u>and that are displaying a current annual</u>
22	snowmobile user fee decal in accordance with Section 41-22-35;
23	(4) off-highway vehicles sold by a dealer to a person who is not a resident of this state;
24	(5) off-highway implements of husbandry operated in the manner prescribed by
25	Subsections 41-22-5.5(3) through (5); and
26	(6) new off-highway vehicles being transported to an off-highway vehicle dealership by
27	the dealer, employee of the dealership, or agent for the dealership.
