**TAKING WILDLIFE WHILE TRESPASSING**

AN ACT RELATING TO WILDLIFE RESOURCES; PROHIBITING THE TAKING OF WILDLIFE WHILE TRESPASSING.

This act affects sections of Utah Code Annotated 1953 as follows:

ENACTS:

**23-20-3.5**, Utah Code Annotated 1953

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

Section 1. Section **23-20-3.5** is enacted to read:

**23-20-3.5. Taking protected wildlife while trespassing -- Penalty.**

(1) Except as provided in this title or a rule, proclamation, or order of the Wildlife Board, a person may not take or permit his dog to take, while in violation of Subsection 23-20-14(2):

- (a) protected wildlife or their parts;
- (b) an occupied nest of protected wildlife; or
- (c) an egg of protected wildlife.

(2) A person is guilty of a class B misdemeanor if he or she violates any provision of Subsection (1).
