17	participation in the purchase of retirement service credit under Section 49-3-410 if the employee:
18	(a) has at least 4 years of state service;
19	(b) has at least 25 years of retirement service credit; and
20	(c) is currently employed by the state.
21	(2) The state participation shall be for \$5,000 for each year of the joint retirement service
22	credit purchase, for a maximum state participation of \$25,000.
23	(3) Any costs for the purchase participation under this section shall be borne by the
24	employing agency and shall not be appropriated by the Legislature.
