17	2000-01, \$150,000 and from the General Fund for fiscal year [1999-2000] 2000-01, \$150,000 to
18	the State Board of Education to be distributed to the State Office of Rehabilitation to purchase
19	assistive technology devices and services in accordance with rules made by the State Board of

21	(b) The money appropriated under Subsection (1)(a) is for base budget funding.
