4. Page 8, Line 236: After "in compliance with" and before "federal 29 CFR" insert ":" and then insert "(i)" to begin a new paragraph.

Page 8, Line 237: After "Administration" but before "." insert ", if the anhydrous ammonia is for agricultural or industrial applications; or (ii) the International Institute of Ammonia Refrigeration (IIAR) standard referred to as American National Standard for Equipment, Design, and Installation of Ammonia Mechanical Refrigerating Systems ANSI/IIAR 2-1999, or the most current edition of this standard approved by the American National Standards Institute (ANSI), if the anhydrous ammonia is for refrigeration applications"
