1. H. B. 205 Appropriation for Intervener Services (G. Adair)

Rep. Adair explained the bill.

Cordie Weed and Steve Ehrlich, deaf/blind adults, and Kirsten Gwilliam, specialist for the deaf and blind, spoke in favor of the bill.

MOTION: Sen. Mayne moved to pass the bill with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed unanimously with Sen. Mansell absent for the vote.

2. **S. B. 220 Bail and Bail Bond Surely Related Amendments** (*L. Poulton*)

Sen. Poulton explained the bill.

Neal Gooch, Deputy Commissioner, Insurance Department, spoke to the bill.

Sen. Poulton moved to pass the bill with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed unanimously.

3. **S. B. 171 Individual Income Tax and Corporate Franchise and Income Tax Credits - Contributions to Providers of Services to Persons with Disabilities**
(*R. Montgomery*)

4. **S. B. 254 Maternity Insurance Coverage for Adoptive Parents** (*E. Mayne*)

10. Page 24, Line 731: After "(2)," bracket "or"
11. Page 24, Line 731: After "(3)" insert ", or (16)"
12. Page 24, Line 737: After "(2)," bracket "or"
13. Page 24, Line 737: After "(3)" insert ", or (16)"
