Senator Lorin Jones called the meeting to order at 9:10 a.m. .

1. S.B. 18 Public Utilities - Sewer Lines (G. Davis)

Sen. Davis explained the bill requires sewer utilities to mark the location of sewer laterals to prevent damage to them when excavation occurs.

Mayor Christiansen, Mt. Pleasant City, said that cities should know where sewer laterals are located.

The following spoke in support of the bill: Frank Warner, Upper Valley Utilities, Haynes Fuller, Upper Valley Utilities, and Casey Quinlen, Upper Valley Utilities.

The following spoke in opposition to the bill: Leland Myers, Central Davis County Sewer District, Mayor of Moab City, and Russ Donahue, Rural Water Users Association.

Sen. Davis requested the committee to hold the bill so he can work with the interested parties to modify the bill.

2. **S.B. 103 Fee for State Golf Courses (L. Blackham)**

Sen. Blackham said the bill increases the fee for golfing at state golf courses.

Steve Roberts, Division of Parks and Recreation spoke in support of the bill.

Rex Black spoke in opposition to the bill.

MOTION: Sen. Hull moved to amend the bill as follows:

Page 2, Line 38: Delete line 38 and insert the following:

"If approved by two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, this act takes effect upon approval by the governor, or the day following the constitutional time limit of Utah Constitution Article VII, Section 8, without the governor's signature, or in the case of a veto, the date of veto override."
