Senator Hillyard assumed the Chair.

Kim Wirthlin, University of Utah Health Sciences Center; Heidi Edlesten, Pleasant Grove High School Esteem Team; Bridget Henriksen, Pleasant Grove High School Esteem Team; and Rod Betit, Executive Director, Department of Health, spoke to the bill.

Senator Muhlestein resumed the Chair.

Bonnie Macri, Executive Director, JEDI for Women, and Steve Barrows, Citizens for Strong Families, spoke to the bill.

MOTION: Senator Davis moved to adopt the following amendments:

1. Page 1, Line 8: Delete "HUNSTMAN"
2. Page 1, Line 9: Delete "CANCER INSTITUTE " and insert "UNIVERSITY OF UTAH HEALTH SCIENCES CENTER"
3. Page 4, Line 104: Delete "to be appropriated to" and insert "for"
4. Page 5, Line 122: Delete "to be appropriated to" and insert "for" and delete "Huntsman Cancer Institute" and insert "University of Utah Health Sciences Center"
5. Page 6, Line 123: Delete "Institute"

The motion passed unanimously, with Senator Hillyard absent for the vote.

MOTION: Senator Poulton moved to adopt the following amendments:

1. Page 4, Line 98: Delete "are" and insert "will be"
2. Page 4, Line 116: Delete "that are available for appropriation in" and insert "received on or before the last day of"
3. Page 4, Line 117: Delete "regardless of the specific date on which they are received,"

The motion passed unanimously, with Senator Hillyard absent for the vote.

MOTION: Senator Allen moved to adopt the following amendments:

1. Page 4, Line 102: After "for" insert "development and employment of a comprehensive unified program for" and after "control" insert ", including reduction efforts for users of all ages;"
2. Page 4, Line 103: Delete Line 103.

The motion failed, with Senators Allen and Davis voting for, and Senators Muhlestein and Poulton voting against the amendments, and Senator Hillyard absent for the vote.

MOTION: Senator Muhlestein moved to adopt the following amendments:

1. Page 1, Line 11: After "ASSESSMENT;" insert "IMPOSING AN ANNUAL REPORTING REQUIREMENT;"
2. Page 4, Line 108: After line 108 insert:
"(5) Each state agency identified in Subsection (4) shall provide an annual report on the program and activities funded under Subsection (4) to:
(a)the Health and Human Services Interim Committee no later than September 1; and
(b)the Health and Human Services Joint Appropriations Subcommittee."

The motion passed unanimously, with Senator Hillyard absent for the vote.

MOTION: Senator Davis moved to pass the bill out favorably, as amended.

The motion passed unanimously, with Senator Hillyard absent for the vote.

MOTION: Senator Davis moved to adjourn.

The motion passed unanimously, with Senator Hillyard absent for the vote, and the meeting adjourned at 5:00 p.m.
