1. H.B. 89S1 PROFESSIONAL LICENSING AMENDMENTS (M. Dayton)

Rep. Margaret Dayton presented the bill. Ray Walker, Enforcement Officer, DOPL, spoke in support of the bill.

MOTION: Sen. Hellewell moved to pass 1st Substitute H.B. "Professional Licensing Amendments" out favorably. The motion passed 3-1-2 with Sen. Spencer, Sen. Hellewell and Sen. Suazo voting in favor and Sen. Valentine voting in opposition with Sen. Dmitrich and Sen. Hillyard absent for the vote.

2. S.B. 193 RESIDENTIAL LIEN RECOVERY FUND (S. Howell)

Sen. Howell introduced attorney John Young who explained the bill and answered questions. Clint Techmeyer, Chairman, Residential Lien Recovery Fund Advisory Board; Jim Paul, Utah Sub-Contractors Counsel; Karman Samone, Salt Lake County Aging

Services; and Stefan Hoskins, Senior Credit Officer, Jack B. Parson Construction, spoke in support of the bill.

MOTION: Sen. Suazo moved to pass S.B. 193, "Residential Lien Recovery Fund" out favorably. The motion failed 1-3-2 with Sen. Suazo voting in favor and Sen. Spencer, Sen. Hellewell and Sen. Valentine voting in opposition with Sen. Dmitrich and Sen. Hillyard absent for the vote.

MOTION: Sen. Valentine moved to adjourn. The motion passed 4-0-2 with Sen. Dmitrich and Sen. Hillyard absent for the vote.
