Committee Chair Waddoups called the meeting to order at 3:25 p.m.

**1. S.B. 123 Utah Heritage Highway Appropriation (L. Blackham)**

Senator Blackham explained the bill, and handouts were distributed.

Susan Holt, President, Utah Heritage Prod. Alliance; Ed Meyer, Director, Utah Heritage Prod. Alliance; and Dennis Judd, Owner, Denny's Wigwam, spoke in favor of the bill.

**MOTION:** Senator Knudson moved to pass the bill out favorably.

The motion passed unanimously.

**2. S.B. 26 Appropriation for Purchase of Freedom Shrine Documents (E. Mayne)**

**MOTION:** Senator Mayne moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 1, Line 6: After "\$19,814" insert "TO THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT TO BE DISTRIBUTED"
2. Page 1, Line 12: After "\$19,814" insert "to the Department of Community and Economic Development to be distributed"

The motion passed unanimously.

Senator Mayne explained the bill and handouts were distributed.

Janice Auger; Mayor, Taylorsville, and Renee Sorensen; President, Taylorsville Exchange Club, spoke in favor of the bill.

**MOTION:** Senator Evans moved to pass the bill out favorably.

The motion passed unanimously, with Senator Knudson absent for the vote.

**3 S.B. 122 Appropriation to State Fire Museum (R. Allen)**

Senator Allen explained the bill.

Steve Lutz, Committee for the State Fire Museum; Dan Tuttle, Board of Directors, Tooele Chamber of Commerce; Robert Adams, Chair, S.L. County Civil Service Commission; Jeff Stansfield, Joint Council Fire Service, S.L. Fire Department; spoke in favor of the bill.

**MOTION:** Senator Julander moved to pass the bill out favorably.

The motion passed unanimously, with Senator Knudson absent for the vote.

**4. S.B. 137 Salvage Vehicle Buyers (J.Valentine)**

Senator Valentine explained the bill.

Senator Mayne moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 1, Line 22: Delete "salvage vehicle" and insert "vehicle with a salvage certificate as defined in Section 41-1a-1001"
2. Page 1, Lines 24-25: Delete "salvage vehicle" and insert "vehicle with a salvage certificate as defined in Section 41-1a-1001"
3. Page 4, Line 106: Delete "salvage vehicle" and insert "vehicle with a salvage certificate as defined in Section 41-1a-1001"

Jerry Schaaf, Farm Bureau Insurance Company; Rick Roundy, President, Rick's Auto Transporting; Rick Baur, Vice President, Mountain States Salvage Pool; Rodney Engh, Co-owner, Rocky Mountain Auto Transport; and Rick Burlingame, Mountain States Salvage Pool, spoke in opposition to the bill.

Senator Mayne assumed the chair.

Steve Williamson, Board Member, Utah Auto Dealers Association; clarified, and spoke in favor of the bill.

**MOTION:** Senator Knudson moved to pass the bill out favorably.

The motion passed, with Senators Knudson, Hale, Julander and Mayne voting for the motion, and Senators Evans and Steele voting in opposition, and Senator Waddoups absent for the vote.

**5. H.B. 194 S1 Appropriation and Spending Limitation Cap - Centennial Highway Fund (M. Stephens)**

Representative Stephens explained the bill.

**MOTION:** Senator Evans moved to pass the bill out favorably.

The motion passed unanimously, with Senator Waddoups absent for the vote.

6. **S.B. 19 Survivor Benefit of Law Enforcement Officer** (*P. Knudson*)

Senator Knudson explained the bill.

Col. Richard Greenwood, Superintendent, Department of Public Safety, spoke in favor of the bill.

**MOTION:** Senator Hale moved to pass the bill out favorably.

The motion passed unanimously, with Senator Waddoups absent for the vote.

7. **H.B. 9 Aggressive Driving Amendments** (*D. Bush*)

Representative Bush explained the bill.

Col. Richard Greenwood, Superintendent, Department of Public Safety; and K. Craig Allred, Director, Utah Highway Safety Office, spoke in favor of the bill.

Representative Loretta Baca expressed concerns about the bill.

**MOTION:** Senator Knudson moved to pass the bill out favorably.

The motion passed unanimously, with Senator Waddoups absent for the vote.

8. **H.B. 165 Transportation Corridor Preservation Act** (*M. Dillree*)

Representative Dillree explained the bill.

Bob Fox, Director of Communications, Utah Department of Transportation, spoke in favor of the bill.

**MOTION:** Senator Evans moved to pass the bill out favorably.

The motion passed unanimously, with Senator Waddoups absent for the vote.

9. **H.B. 31 Operation of Nonresident Owned Snowmobile** (*D. Bowman*)

Representative Bowman explained the bill.

**MOTION:** Senator Knudson moved to pass the bill out favorably.

The motion passed unanimously, with Senator Waddoups absent for the vote.

**MOTION:** Senator Julander moved to adjourn.

The motion passed unanimously at 5:15 p.m., with Senator Waddoups absent for the vote.
