

**SEARCH WARRANT AMENDMENT**

**This act modifies the Code of Criminal Procedure regarding search warrants by providing a specific definition of the term "daytime."**

This act affects sections of Utah Code Annotated 1953 as follows:

AMENDS:

**77-23-201**, as renumbered and amended by Chapter 142, Laws of Utah 1994

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

Section 1. Section **77-23-201** is amended to read:

**77-23-201. "Search warrant" defined.**

~~[A search]~~ As used in this part:

(1) "Daytime" means the hours beginning at 6 a.m. and ending at 10 p.m. local time.

(2) "Search warrant" is an order issued by a magistrate in the name of the state and directed to a peace officer, describing with particularity the thing, place, or person to be searched and the property or evidence to be seized by him and brought before the magistrate.
